Opening of Bids will immediately follow at the 3rd Floor Conference Room of BFP-NCR Regional Headquarters in the presence of COA auditors and bidder's representative. No bids shall be accepted earlier than the said date.

The above properties may be inspected anytime during office hours (8AM-5PM). Inspection is at the discretion of the bidder.

This Committee reserves the right to 1) reject any or all bids; 2) waive defects or informalities therein; 3) or accept any bid which the members of the Committee consider to be the most advantageous and beneficial to the government.

The prices that will be offered should not be less than the floor price as appraised by this Committee. The winning bidders will be announced thereafter.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The bidding is open to the public. The herein terms and conditions conform to the DBM Manual on Disposal of Government Property (National Budget Circular No. 425, January 28, 1992).
2. Only bids from parties and their authorized representatives who have been duly issued the Bid Documents shall be opened. Bids from parties who have not been issued the Bid Documents will be rejected outright.
3. Sealed bids shall be for all items described in the Invitation to Bid on an "AS IS, WHERE IS" and "CASH and CARRY" basis.
4. A bidder shall accomplish the Bid Tender in at least three (3) copies, preferably typewritten. Bid tenders should be properly signed and submitted to the Chairman of the Disposal Committee on or before the time scheduled for the opening of the bids. The envelope containing the bid tender should be sealed with signature and addressed properly and correctly indicating the Item Number. If the items are being sold by lots, bidders shall submit bid tenders for different lots in separate envelopes.
5. Sealed bids for the lot must not be lower than the minimum bid prices as indicated in the Invitation to Bid.
6. Bid bond per item/lot, as the case may be, which shall accompany the bid tender or is presented at the time of opening of bids, shall be required from each bidder and should be at least 10% of the minimum bid price set by the government. Bid bonds should be in the form of cash, manager's check, or cashier's check (payable to the BFP-NCR) acquired from a reputable bank within the area where bidding is to be held.
7. In the presence of participating bidders, and the COA Auditor/s, the Disposal Committee of BFP-NCR REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS, at the time and date stated in the Invitation to Bid, shall open all sealed bids submitted, and thereafter, submit its report and recommendation to the Regional Director of BFP-NCR for approval.
8. The winning bidder shall, after paying the approved bid price/s with the BFP-NCR Financial Disbursement Section, remove/haul the subject unserviceable properties from the premises of this Office within Seven (7) Working Days and shall shoulder all expenses relative thereto.
